In the academic year 1990/1991 a new trend was started in environmental education at the Faculty and the special branch "Environmental Sciences" was created. It had formerly been known as specialization of the "Protection of Natural Environment" (1977-86) and "Protection and Development of the Environment" (1986-91). The undergraduate and graduate studies ideally integrate the classic courses in nature conservation and intelligent use of natural resources. The goal of the study is to train specialists in nature and environment, to give them practical experience in laboratory and fieldwork, to teach a theoretical and methodological basis of interdisciplinary environmental research so that methodological processes needed for obtaining and managing information with regard to the environment can be obtained.

The Comenius University in Bratislava



The Comenius University in Bratislava is the oldest university in the Slovak Republic. It was founded on June 27th, 1919 and follows the university tradition of the Academia Istropolitana which was established in Bratislava by Matthias Corvinus, the Hungarian King, in 1465. It is named after Comenius, a 17th century Czech teacher and philosopher with Slovak ancestors and comprises thirteen faculties.

The Faculty of Natural Sciences is one of the greatest research-educational institutions of the Comenius University of Bratislava. The faculty was established in 1940 and can be compared with similar institutions in neighboring countries, as well as in the European Union.

The Faculty of Natural Sciences is a research-oriented faculty, conducting basic and applied research of all fields of Natural Sciences.

The faculty currently offers BSc and MSc programs in 7 majors: Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geography, Geology Geography and public administration and Teacher-Education in Natural Sciences, with many specializations in each.

The importance of PhD study is particularly emphasized and the students can choose from 36 different subjects.

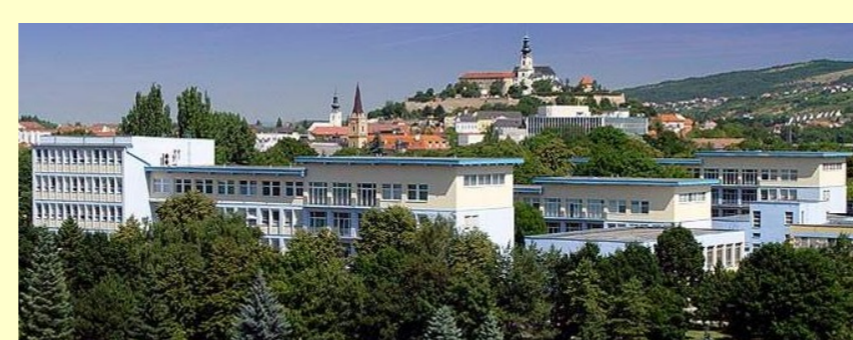

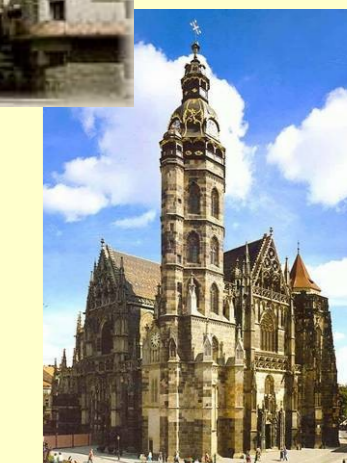
Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice

Technical university in Zvolen

Queen Maria Theresa transformed the first mining school in Banská Štiavnica (founded in 1735 by Samuel Mikoviny) into the Mining Academy in 1762, thus creating the first institution of higher technical education in the world. In 1991 the new independent Faculty of Ecology, presently the Faculty of Ecology and Environmental Sciences was established and since school year 2006/2007 it is based in Zvolen.
